Pickleball Club information

Did you know That while the Pickleball Club manages the Pickleball Courts, we have to follow the rules the CBOD sets for managing the courts: VGCC Rule 1.23 Pickleball Play. Per The Villages rules, anyone who wants to use our courts must be registered. To register to play, you must fill in two forms: one is a club application, the second one is for our registration system, YourCourts. Both are available on our website: https://villagespickleball.org. Full instructions (including videos) are available online.

When registering, you must make one of two selections: Member or Non-Member Resident. Both types of accounts can make registrations, but there are differences in what they can do.

As a member you are entitled to the following benefits for a \$15.00 annual fee.

- Unlimited participation in level specific group play
- Use of Pickleball Ball machine for \$10 per year, \$5 for key once our storage shed is approved & installed
- Participate in club tournaments
- Attend Club social events
- Discounted price on Onix 2 Pure balls, the only balls allowed on our courts
- Free unlimited demonstrations with the use of club owned paddles that you can try before you buy (contact Mike Walias at mjw0275@yahoo.com)

Non-member residents may participate in up to two demonstrations or group play sessions, after which membership is required.

Per the San Jose Planning Commission, anyone using the courts **must** use paddles on the Villages Approved Paddle list (<u>located here on our website</u>). Paddles marked USAPA Approved does not ensure a paddle is approved. Please always check the list before purchasing. Additionally, only yellow Onix 2 Pure balls are allowed on our courts. They can be purchased through the club at a discounted price, as we buy in bulk. We pass the savings onto our members, allowing you to play less than you can buy online or in stores!
