1. Party:

6. Fund Raising Status –
  - a. Finance company is holding off on approaching the board with the bricks until the board approves the location on the advice of the Board
  - b. We are waiting for bricks and location before asking for funding, so we can present this to potential donors
7. Court Progress
  - a. Things are progressing well, individuals have been meeting with the board and resistance seems to be abating to our proposed site
  - b. An informative document will be distributed to all residents. This is currently being submitted by Anahid for review
