The following are rules I have heard discussed/questioned on the courts recently.

For clarification:

1. The entire score must be called BEFORE the server begins his or her service motion. This allows for discussion, if necessary, before play starts.
2. Double taps are legal, as long as it happens during one continuous motion, without a second intentional swing.
3. This one is supposedly unusual but I have seen it three times in the last few weeks. The ball is struck with so much backspin it bounces in the kitchen and then back over the net on its own! The point goes to the player that hit the ball. The receiver may reach over the net to strike the ball before it bounces in the original court. If the receiver is able to do this the ball remains in play. The receiver may not touch the net and their foot can not move under the net to the other side of the court.
