- Treasurer's Report: Beginning balance=\$8235. Income=\$1135.

- Publicity: Joyce is looking for more ideas on articles a for The Villager. One suggestion she mentioned was the "Out Call" rule: if the opposing team cannot make a decision on the call, it defers to the team that hit the ball.
- Group Play Updates: No new issues. Novice Group play will hold 1 court if 3 or more people sign up for Thursday afternoon. On Tuesday's Novice group play, 2 courts will be held if 5 or more people sign up. For Intermediate & Advanced Group Play, the word "instructional" has been removed on Your Courts. A thanks was given to Larry & Donna for their instructional advice in the Novice groups.
- New Business: We are waiting to find out about possible reimbursement from The Club for the Ball machine Shed. After Labor Day, we will start organizing for usage off the machine. Anahid will republish the link to all members to verify who wants to use it. It will only be available for usage

between noon & 4:30 PM. Steve & Anahid have created a survey to go to all members, asking about members' usage & whether or not they would be interested in changing to 1 hour sessions, thereby creating more time slots. This survey goes to the Board first for fine tuning & will then go out to all members. Steve asked that Board Members return it by 8/25.
