Secretary's Report: Motion was made to approve the minutes as read by Anahid Gregg and seconded by Karen Ruth.

Membership Update: Anahid reported we now have 545 members including 5 new members and 101 non members. She will check to see if we are the largest paying membership club in the Villages

Treasurer's Report: Sherry reported we have moved \$4013.00 from the general fund to the ball machine fund. This included dues and keys for 2024 & 2025. The General Fund Balance is now \$19,247.98. The question was asked if the expenses for the ball machine should also be included in the ball machine fund. It was decided it would be a good idea and Sherry will get those figures for 2024 & 2025 and transfer them by the next meeting.

The income was \$6233.00 and expenses was \$6611.29. The final balance to date is \$18,869.69. The breakdown is listed in the Treasurer's Report at the end of the minutes.

Tournament/Social Director: Karen reported that the Spring Fling was a fun day. We had lively competition with Silver Creek with the final score of 19-13 with Villages winning. Good job, Karen with putting together some close matches. Our next tournament is June 7th. It's going to be a round robin.

Anahid would like to get a second plaque for the Silver Creek Tournament to be put up in the clubhouse. Karen made a motion with Anahid seconding for Anahid to spend \$200 and it was unanimously approved. This is contingent upon approval from Clay or Albert.

NEW BUSINESS:

Kim suggested making signs be put up on the courts for Dink & Drink noting Advanced Novice/Intermediate & Advanced Intermediate/Advanced. This came about to help people find their ability level. The new times for Dink & Drink will begin at 4:30-7:30 going forward.

Larry Rosen is in charge the of the ball machine maintenance with Tim and Arthur as his backup. Spare parts have been purchased by Larry to stay ahead of the maintenance needs of the ball machine.

OLD BUSINESS:

- We are still waiting for clearance from the Club regarding the Pickleball Pros status.

- Michelle has asked Anahid to manage the Taco Truck for the 10th Anniversary Celebration and she will take care of the decorations, etc. It was decided that there will be a charge of \$5 for members and \$10 for nonmembers. Water and sodas will be included and it will be a BYOB for people that want alcohol.
- Clay said the benches inside the courts will be moved to outside the courts and there will be replacements for inside the courts.

Karen made a motion to adjourn at it was seconded by Anahid at 5:40 PM.
