

Pickleball Board Meeting Minutes
February 13, 2026

Attendance: David Wong, Anahid Gregg, Tammy Ehle, Sherry Benz, Linda Eige, Arthur Yu and Joyce Kludt.

The president, David Wong, called the meeting to order at 4:30 PM.

Anahid moved that the minutes of the 1/8/26 meeting be approved. Joyce 2nd the motion and it passed unanimously.

Membership Report: Anahid reported that we have 522 members, 107 non-member residents and 3 social members. There were 51 membership cancellations due to move-outs, death or age-related reasons. No dissatisfaction with the Pickle Ball Club was stated.

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer's report was accepted. Income included 2026 membership dues and ball machine dues.

Social Director: The first Dink & Drink is scheduled for March 13th.

Tournament Director: Karen reported that there will be 7 tournaments in 2026 including the Silver Creek and Rossmoor exchanges. The dates are all listed on the website. She has encouraged folks to find a partner and practice with their partner so they will be ready to sign up for any tournament.

New Business:

- **Intermediate Play:** The intermediate open play group has requested an additional court on Mondays at 11:00AM. The Board did not feel that the number of sign-ups warranted another reserved court and voted not to approve. If the group wishes to have an additional court, they can sign up as individuals.
- **Golf Cart Parking:** A complaint was received stating that people were parking golf carts on the curb rather than in the cart parking lot, taking space from automobiles. David will send an email asking players to observe this as a courtesy and the request will be posted on Your Courts.
- **Ball Machine Play:** There is a rule that Ball Machine members may only reserve the ball machine 1x/week. However, Your Courts does not limit the reservations. Therefore, players have reserved it multiple times/week and it does not count against the maximum court usage for weekly count and prime time count. Anahid moved that reservations for the ball machine we added to the weekly and prime time count. Arthur 2nd the motion and it was passed unanimously.
- **Paddles:** Only 76 players have responded to list their paddles. This is to confirm that all paddles used are approved. A request will be resent. Ginny Spencer is handling the paddle information.
- **Member Complaints:** Currently, a member can make a suggestion or file a complaint at the Pickleball Website. Anahid receives this correspondence and replies, most often after consulting with David. The question arose: Does the person expect that this request is going to the Board and should the entire Board be involved? David suggested that the Board be blind-copied in such circumstances.
- **Appreciation:** Anahid proposed that we give a gift of appreciation to Donna Quartaro, Mike Walias, Larry Mortenson and Larry Rosene for their much-appreciated service to the Pickleball Club. Discussion was held regarding the appropriateness of giving gifts for volunteering. The matter was tabled.
- **Pickleball Pros:** Debbie Bloom does not want to meet the requirements of the Villages and, with no guarantees of lessons, has asked to be removed from consideration. Gil Cepada has not responded, leaving uncertainty that he wants to pursue consideration.

Old Business:

- The disciplinary hearing for PB Member has been rescheduled ... again.
